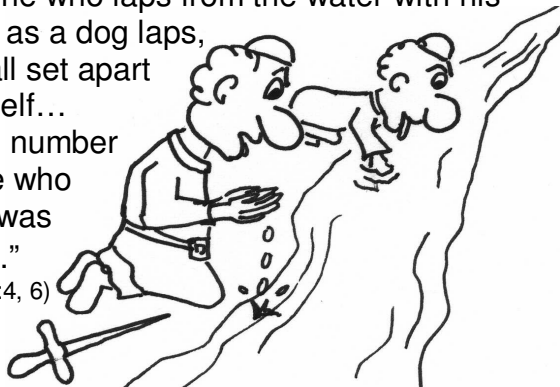

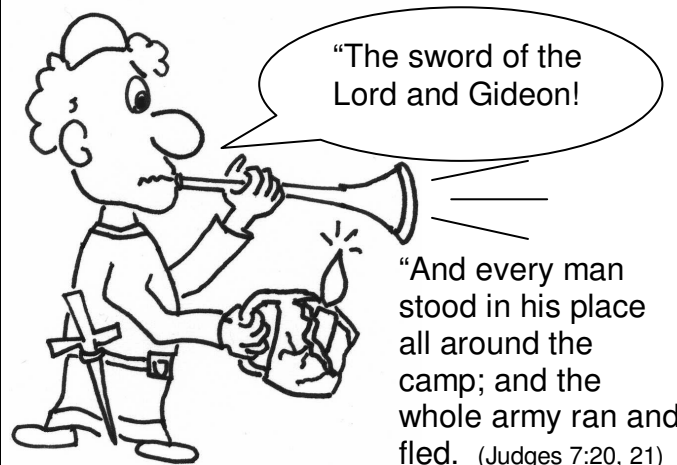
5. "The Lord said to Gideon, the people are still too many... Bring them down to the water and I will test them for you."
