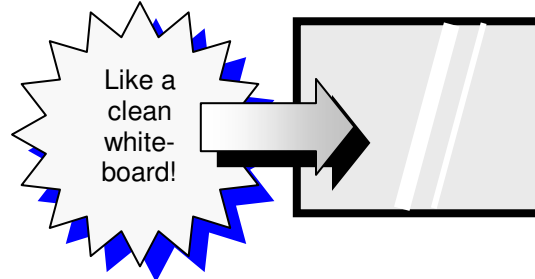


07. "Expiation"

"To take action to remove the stain of guilt"

Expiation applies to guilt. It means that guilt is...

Under the Covenant Law in Israel, the peoples' sins were "expiated" when the blood of an innocent lamb was shed instead of the blood of the sinners.

Expiation means the demands of the Law were met and the sins were removed.



Under the New Covenant – the Covenant of Grace, expiation was made for our sins when Jesus consented to stand in as our substitutes, and suffer the death of the cross as the only spotless Lamb of God! He wiped the slate clean through His death. **He expiated our guilt** before the Father.

Expiation – To wipe clean our guilt!
