

10. "Imputation"

**To impute means "to assign to."
Imputation is an assignment.**

The sin of Adam was imputed (assigned by God) to all his descendants. None of us is righteous (Romans 3:10). We all have a sin-nature and all are guilty of sin.

(Romans 3:10 NKJV) "As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one;"

Jesus paid a debt he did not owe so we would not have to pay a debt we could not pay!

When you accept Christ as your Savior and Lord, two incredible events take place which remove your sentence of eternal death.

1. Christ's righteousness is imputed, or assigned to you!
2. Your sins are imputed, or assigned to Christ He answered for our crimes against God.

Only God can impute or assign guilt or innocence.

(Romans 4:11 NKJV) "And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which he had while still uncircumcised, that he might be the father of all those who believe, though they are uncircumcised, that righteousness might be imputed to them also,"

(Romans 4:23-24 NKJV) "Now it was not written for his sake alone that it was imputed to him, {24} but also for us. It shall be imputed to us who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead,"
